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






















President's Insight:

Behind Innovation and Progress





eace exudes from Davor Ljevar although he hails from the once war-torn country of Croatia. Now that the figurative smoke has cleared, this determined entrepreneur has forged his way to shoot his shot at life and all of the prosperity that it has to offer.

When Ljevar thinks of his own experiences with war, what emotions surface and what thoughts does he have about how far he has come, knowing that he has not only survived but thrived?

Ljevar shared, "The first reaction is certainly sadness and thinking, how can this happen again nowadays in a developed civilization? It is completely senseless. When I think about where I've come in my career, I'm certainly satisfied with what I've achieved so far, considering that I come from a small country that was completely devastated not so long ago and went through a turbulent transition process. So, you can still hear and feel the 'voice' of the past and success is not always positively received."

In spite of the negative experiences, he holds strong to a positive mindset and a rose-tinted view of his beloved country. So much so, that if he had to 'sell' Croatia in one paragraph, his offering would be, "Come and experience it! Croatia has a lot to offer - rich culture, architecture, beautiful nature, great gastronomy. No matter the type of person you are, if you like sipping wine in a vineyard, chilling or partying on a beach, or riding a quad (or a horse) through the mountains, you'll find it here.

However, open, warm and hardworking people are probably the greatest quality of Croatia and I believe anybody who encounters them, businesswise or leisure-wise, can confirm this."

Ljevar is the CEO of Demil Tech Ltd., a company that handles industrial demilitarization. It is somewhat understandable why he has chosen this path considering his past experiences but what exactly is industrial demilitarization?

He explained the objective behind it, "Industrial demilitarization encompasses the processes of storage, transportation, disassembly, disposal, destruction and recycling of explosives, ammunition and explosive components. The advantage of industrial demilitarization compared to other methods of disposing of surplus obsolete ammunition is that it strives for environmentally friendly technologies, waste reduction, recycling and reuse of materials exclusively for civilian purposes."

Regarding its importance in the grand scheme of things, he continued, "Industrial demilitarization is important because, on the one hand, it reduces the risks of accidents, sometimes catastrophic, that occur due to the storage of obsolete ammunition, which consequently has a large negative impact on the environment, the community and government budgets. On the other hand, industrial demilitarization returns materials, sometimes precious metals, to industry, and thus, supports the principles of the circular economy."

This type of work is not common knowledge for many and it offers a fascinating look into how sustainability is factored into many industries. How does it work for industrial demilitarization to pair





with achieving clean and environmentally friendly demilitarization technology?

Ljevar stated, "Industrial demilitarization is a product of the desire to solve the problem of obsolete ammunition in an environmentally friendly way and to reduce the impact on the environment to the lowest possible level. Today's technologies allow for minimal impact on the environment when implementing industrial demilitarization, which certainly places us among green technologies."

His personal power has granted him a formidable character that has been exemplified through his upward mobility in reaching this career height. What exactly propelled him to pursue this career course and enough so to start the Demil Tech Ltd. legacy?

"At Demil Tech, called ISL Spreewerk 15 years ago, which was part of the General Atomics group, I started as a production engineer, quickly progressed to production manager, and in 2014, I was appointed (as the) CEO.

In 2020, I took over majority ownership of the company, which was then renamed Demil Tech. The main guiding principle in taking over the company and deciding to continue in this industry was the fact that many countries had significant amounts of obsolete ammunition that needed to be disposed of, and we had vast experience in the disposal that we had accumulated over the years

disposing of obsolete ammunition in Croatia and surrounding countries. The same thing guides me today, being aware of our experience and knowledge, and we continue to strive to market our knowledge and technology to reduce risk and increase general safety."

Self-motivation apparent, on a personal note, what truly motivates him, generally speaking? "The aspiration and natural instinct to create added value, whether in my private life or work, motivates me and keeps me going. Besides that, developing myself as a person but also developing and drawing out the potential from my colleagues and family members to create something that will make the world a better place and leave something good and positive behind."

As the recently appointed Delegate for Croatia at the Global Chamber of Business Leaders (GCBL), the parent organization of the Global Trends Magazine (GTM), he maintains his commitment to serve, educate and make a difference. What is his vision now as the Delegate for Croatia?

Answered Ljevar, "I will strive to justify my role as a Delegate by helping young and promising Croatian companies enter the global market through the network provided by GCBL but also through my personal experiences gained through work, in order to make it easier for them to realize their potential. Furthermore, I will strive to present Croatia as a country open to investment, development and business in general. Through





this method of operation, I believe that (the) GCBL will benefit in many ways and gain new members and supporters."

Knowing how important support, mentorship, networks and basic humanity are when it comes to opportunities and personal growth and development, he said as he noted the trends of people in general, "I am certainly saddened by the fact that people have become alienated from each other. They do not care much about each other. The struggle for personal interest to the detriment of others prevails in every aspect, which is certainly most expressed in armed conflicts that are drastically spreading. However, despite all the bad things happening, it is encouraging that there are still people and organizations who strive to make life and work easier for those in need and who care about healthy development, the preservation of the environment and civilization as a whole."

Ljevar shared his view on how mentorship of startup Founders should be approached, generally speaking.

"They need to be encouraged to push forward, to develop their ideas and never give up. No matter

how hard it is, how many obstacles they encounter or how misunderstood by others they are, they need to believe in themselves, their ideas and keep going. Success will come."

His passion for educating the masses being evident, in what way/s would he or could he





educate people about the work that he does and its merits? "The best way for me is a 'live' presentation of our work and activities, achievements and goals. Most people do not understand the work we do, which is understandable considering that the activity is very rare and self-contained, and the best reaction and understanding came after a 'live' presentation where they can 'feel' what we do."

Turning his attention back to the Global Chamber of Business Leaders, he hinted at how he could partner with the GCBL in the future to actively shape mentalities within learning forums and also create charitable ventures. "I can openly provide (the) GCBL with my acquired knowledge, experience, connections and ideas to move forward together and make the world a better place."

His inclinations are on par with the initiative of the Global Chamber of Business Leaders, which is the Global Coalition for Cooperation and Peace (GCCP). This entity was launched last year. It is an organizational clarion call for global leaders and international power players to put egos and even personal gain aside and truly work for the progress of and peace among their citizens. It is also a

prompt for relevant organizations to step-up their own actions and collaborate with other entities for more robust solutions.

Seeing how physical wars have become almost a normal situation in certain parts of the world, how does Ljevar mentally treat with these unfortunate occurrences?

Pensively, he responded, "Considering that I spent part of my childhood surrounded by war and the horrors of war, I completely understand what these people, especially children, are going through. This is a catastrophic situation and ultimately does no good to anyone. The only thing I can personally do is continue to work in my industry, which directly reduces the potential for war, which certainly helps me cope with the horrors that surround us."

Ultimately, what lesson/s did those experiences teach him and how did they impact his outlook on life? "It certainly taught me that nothing in life is certain, it's not permanent and we can't take anything for granted. So for everything in life – family, success, peace – you have to work, work

dedicatedly and constantly. There is no alternative path."

Ljevar looks forward to continuing his career being figuratively of military grade and wishing for a world that seeks sustainability in all areas.

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

World Trends 2025, Global Trends Magazine, 24

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s the world steps into 2025, a complex tapestry of economic, geopolitical, environmental, and social trends is shaping the global landscape. This pivotal year demands unprecedented cooperation and strategic foresight as nations, organizations, and individuals grapple with critical challenges and opportunities.

Semih San

ne of the meanings of Semih San's first name is "generous". Heartened by the fact that his name was researched, he was full of gratitude. As he regarded the sentiment, he expressed how he has contributed in his own ways to the upliftment and betterment of humanity.

Said San, "I try to live according to the meaning of my name. To ensure this, I am actively involved in many humanitarian aid organizations working in the Turkish and international arenas. I am making an effort to ensure that the people living in the Balkans region, which I have shown great interest in due to my work and family origin, live in an atmosphere of peace and brotherhood."

San hails from Turkiye, a nation with a population of over 85 million. One in an ocean of people, he has anchored himself in the philanthropic arena as much as possible.

What is a general little-known secret of Turkiye though? About his country, he said, "The fact that Turkiye is the heart of the modern world due to its

geopolitical, economic and sociocultural position is one of the little-known general secrets."

His perspectives immediately position him as an ambassador, and now as the recently appointed Delegate for Turkiye at the Global Chamber of Business Leaders (GCBL) - the managing entity of the Global Trends Magazine (GTM) - he gets the opportunity to significantly demonstrate Turkiye's prowess. "I thank President **Dejan Štancer** for considering this role worthy of me and (I will) try to do my best for the development of Turkiye and international trade.

Turkiye is the intersection point of the world as it acts as a bridge between the Middle East, Europe, Asia and Africa. Turkiye, which can experience four





seasons at the same time, is a real tourism and shopping paradise with its natural beauties and history. For this reason, there is a very profitable market in business tourism."

San is an entrepreneur within the field of International Trade. He answered, "I started my international trade career in order to improve myself in the international field and markets, to contribute positively to the business world and to meet new names who have a say in the business world. Everyone has a role in life and that's the role I chose for myself. I chose to make a small contribution to the developing commercial life between the Middle East and EU countries.

I'm focused on the trade of textiles, leather, cosmetics, bags, gold, construction equipment, timber, machinery, health products and tourism industries."

His focus is specific as his efforts are towards certain regions, namely, Balkan and Central Asian countries. What were some of the challenges or issues in these regions/countries that he felt he could address in business?

San divulged, "Balkan and Central Asian countries began to make rapid development and progress after the collapse of the Soviet Union. For this reason, there are many sectors that can be developed as an international economy and business world. For this development, we are





making great efforts to change some of the habits left over from the socialist economy model."

Speaking on global trade challenges, he declared, "Armed conflicts all around the world are affecting world trade negatively. Where there is peace, everybody wins and trade becomes safer and more secure. In order for trade to develop, everyone should live in peace. This is one of our most important missions as the GCBL."

The point of the GCBL founding the Global Coalition for Cooperation and Peace (GCCP) last year and the objective being to take on the monumental task of helping to forge paths towards unity, peace relations, humanitarian acts and global cooperation across borders were raised.

How does he think he can leverage his experience with philanthropic work to be an asset in this thrust of the GCBL and GCCP?

San revealed, "I think that the many connections we have made between the people of Turkiye and the countries of the region will make a very

A believer in 'giving back', he has devoted countless hours towards working with orphaned children. He is in full support of programs that assist orphaned children in the sphere of education and his philanthropic work has been centred around this. Of his mission, he shared, "I am trying to do my best to educate orphans around the world, especially in Turkiye, and I think





that this effort should remain hidden due to the background that the culture I grew up in provides me. As a proverb in our country says, 'Do good and throw it into the sea.'"

No doubt experiencing a wave of emotions, he said, "If I had all the funds, I would have worked to achieve world peace and end global starvation."

There is a saying reportedly from Matshona Dhliwayo that says, "The seed you plant today determines the harvest you reap tomorrow." The youths of today will be the leaders of tomorrow and like many, San is aware that investing in the personal development and mentorship of youths and young adults can reap a wealth of rewards in the future. It can truly take a village, and so, even corporate bodies can become involved.

What Is Love Tourism

- The organisers of the events would usually have strict rules and guidelines for participants to follow in order to facilitate the safety and protect the confidentiality of everyone.
- Events are primarily limited to controlled venues so that interactions are contained. As such, there is no room for participants to venture into unknown territories by their own virtue or because they were duped by a stranger posing as an interested participant.


The cons include:

hy Homelessness is Not Just A 'Them' Problem

Transportation barriers and fewer job opportunities further exacerbate the problem in these areas.


A Silent Crisis:

NEARLY A QUARTER OF FRESHWATE SPECIES FACE EXTINCTIO

reshwater ecosystems, home to an extraordinary diversity of life, are under severe threat. A new study has revealed that nearly 24% of animals relying on rivers, lakes, wetlands, and other freshwater sources are at risk of extinction. The culprits? Climate change, pollution, damming of rivers, invasive species, and unsustainable agricultural practices—all combining to create a perfect storm for these fragile ecosystems.

Alarming Findings

The study examined the status of approximately 23,500 freshwater species, including dragonflies, fish, crabs, and other organisms dependent on these habitats. Of these species, nearly a quarter are classified as vulnerable, endangered, or critically endangered. Unlike terrestrial habitats, freshwater ecosystems—though covering less than 1% of Earth's surface—are home to 10% of the world's known species, making their preservation crucial.

"Massive rivers like the Amazon might seem invincible, but freshwater environments are some of the most fragile ecosystems on Earth," explains Patricia Charvet, a biologist from Brazil's Federal University of Ceará and co-author of the study.

The Global Impact

Since 1900, the world has lost more than 70% of its wetlands, and populations in freshwater habitats have plummeted by 84%.

The findings highlight that freshwater biodiversity is declining faster than any other ecosystem type. The reasons are multifaceted:

- Dams and River Fragmentation: Only one-third
 of the world's rivers remain free-flowing, with
 infrastructure cutting off critical migration paths
 for species.
- Pollution: Chemicals, plastic waste, and agricultural runoff are poisoning these ecosystems.



- Overexploitation: Unsustainable fishing and sand mining are depleting resources.
- Climate Change: Rising temperatures and unpredictable weather patterns are altering water flow and quality.

Regional Insights

In South America, the Amazon River basin—a biodiversity hotspot—is grappling with deforestation, illegal gold mining, and devastating forest fires. Charvet points out how illegal miners discharge toxic heavy metals into waterways, while ash clouds from wildfires pollute the air and water

Similarly, in North America and Europe, major rivers like the Mississippi and the Rhine are heavily altered by dams and industrial activity, disrupting ecosystems that have thrived for millennia.

A Call to Action


The study, published in Nature, is the first of its kind to assess global risks to freshwater species. Catherine Sayer, a zoologist with the International Union for Conservation of Nature, underscores the urgency: "Most species face multiple threats simultaneously, and these combined pressures are pushing many to the brink of extinction."

To reverse these trends, immediate action is required:

- Restore Free-Flowing Rivers: Removing unnecessary dams and allowing rivers to flow naturally can help species recover.

- Protect Wetlands: Conserving and restoring wetlands will provide a lifeline for countless species.





There are even many positive outcomes and successful developments in a corporate context within the field of Art and Business.

I've shared my contributions in a program at an international team-building event of a multinational IT brand that was designed to interactively bring music, song and dance to 350 participants from a total of ten countries that were 90% male. With absolutely no previous knowledge or rehearsals, all were encouraged to, and learned to sing together to create their corporation's values and mission statement!

This is called Polyphony, which means in musical terms: multi-voiced rhythms and melodies - tunes in harmony which can be successfully conducted and structured. In a classical music tradition of many hundred years of European history, the format of symphony orchestra and choir is the highest form of social interaction with total inclusion of the individual's diversity in its competence. Music through this format then becomes a co-creation of a masterpiece and reflects that every single participant finds their rightful place in the community.

Tips For Busy Professional Mothers

There are ways for mothers (and fathers too) to creatively use music for their child's recreation, entertainment and general learning.

Overall, family well-being can be greatly influenced through music. Music is important to a

child's development because they need to feel love through their mother or parent's voice and smile. The first sounds that a fetus ever hears is in pregnancy - the rhythm of their mother's heartbeat and then the melody in the mother's or father's voice that produces a calming and invigorating effect.

hat is hMPV? Human metapneumovirus (hMPV) is a respiratory virus first identified in 2001. It belongs to the same family as respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) and shares similarities with other respiratory viruses such as influenza and coronaviruses.

Virus hMPV primarily causes upper and lower respiratory tract infections, ranging from mild cold-like symptoms to severe respiratory illnesses, especially in vulnerable populations such as young children, older adults, and individuals with weakened immune systems.

Symptoms of hMPV include:

- Cough
- · Nasal congestion
- Shortness of breath
- Fever
- Wheezing

In severe cases, it can lead to pneumonia or bronchiolitis, necessitating hospitalization. Like other respiratory viruses, hMPV spreads through respiratory droplets and contact with contaminated surfaces.

The Current Situation in China and Elsewhere

Reports from China and other regions indicate a notable uptick in hMPV cases during the winter months, coinciding with the typical respiratory virus season. In China, hospitals have been overwhelmed with patients experiencing respiratory symptoms, with hMPV identified as a significant contributor to the surge.

Similar trends are being observed in parts of Europe and North America, raising questions about whether this virus is evolving or if enhanced surveillance and testing are simply uncovering a long-standing seasonal pathogen.





The surge in cases comes against the backdrop of heightened awareness and monitoring of respiratory viruses following the COVID-19 pandemic. Increased testing capabilities, coupled with a growing population of individuals seeking care for respiratory illnesses, may explain the rising numbers. However, researchers are investigating whether new strains of hMPV are emerging that could be more transmissible or severe.

Could hMPV Spark a New Pandemic?

The possibility of hMPV causing a pandemic similar to COVID-19 is a legitimate concern but requires careful evaluation. Here are some factors to consider:

1. Transmission:

HMPV spreads efficiently among humans, particularly in close-contact settings, but it does not appear to have the explosive transmissibility seen with SARS-CoV-2.

2. Severity:

While hMPV can cause severe illness in high-risk groups, the overall case fatality rate remains low compared to diseases like COVID-19. Most infections resolve without complications in healthy individuals.

3. Immunity:

Unlike COVID-19, where humans had no preexisting immunity, hMPV has been circulating globally for decades. Many individuals have been exposed to it in childhood, providing some level of immunity.

4. Vaccine and Treatment:

There is currently no specific vaccine or antiviral treatment for hMPV, but its similarity to RSV suggests that research into preventive measures may accelerate. Supportive care remains the





mainstay of treatment, and ongoing efforts in vaccine development are promising.

The Global Response

Health authorities in China and worldwide are closely monitoring the situation. Surveillance programs are being expanded to track hMPV cases, and public health campaigns are emphasizing the importance of hygiene measures such as handwashing and mask-wearing in crowded spaces.

Researchers are also examining the genetic makeup of circulating hMPV strains to identify potential mutations that could impact its behavior. Collaboration between governments, public health organizations, and the private sector will be crucial in addressing this emerging threat.

Should We Be Concerned?

While hMPV is not currently considered a pandemic-level threat, its impact on healthcare systems and vulnerable populations warrants attention.

The lessons learned from COVID-19 highlight the importance of early detection, transparent communication, and proactive measures to mitigate the spread of infectious diseases.

The uptick in hMPV cases serves as a reminder of the need for robust global health systems capable of managing both seasonal and emerging pathogens. It also underscores the importance of investing in vaccine research and antiviral development for a broader range of respiratory viruses.

- Stay Updated: Regularly update your device's operating system to include the latest security patches.
- Be Cautious with Permissions: Avoid granting excessive permissions to apps, particularly if they request access to sensitive data.







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SACHER TORTE:

A SLICE OF HISTORY, ELEGAND CHOCOLAT

- **4.Set the Glaze:** Allow the cake to sit at room temperature until the glaze firms up.
- **5.Serve:** Traditionally, Sacher Torte is served with a generous dollop of unsweetened whipped cream, balancing the cake's rich chocolate profile.



This stark forecast underscores the fragility of the banana supply chain, which is being tested by both climate impacts and disease outbreaks. If production cannot keep pace with





global demand, higher prices may be the new norm, forcing consumers to reconsider their grocery budgets.

Industry Leaders Meet in Rome:

A Focus on Sustainability

Amid these challenges, stakeholders from the banana industry recently gathered in Rome to explore strategies for navigating the uncertain future. A key theme of their discussions was the push for greater sustainability, a concept that has gained increasing importance among consumers and industry leaders alike.

Nauru's Struggle, Global Trends Magazine, 24th Edition 2025

n the vast expanse of the Pacific Ocean lies Nauru, the world's smallest republic. Covering just 21 square kilometers, this tiny island nation has a history as rich as its once-abundant phosphate deposits. From colonial rule to economic booms and near collapse, Nauru's journey to independence and beyond is a remarkable tale of resilience, resource exploitation, and survival.

From Ancient Tribes to Colonial Rule

For over 3,000 years, Nauru was home to Polynesian and Micronesian settlers, living in a clan-based society of 12 tribes—symbolized today by the 12-pointed star on the national flag. The island thrived on fishing and coconut farming, its serene lagoon providing a steady food supply.

In 1798, British captain John Fearn became the first European to set eyes on Nauru, dubbing it "Pleasant Island" for its lush scenery and friendly inhabitants. However, the arrival of whalers and traders in the 19th century brought firearms, igniting tribal wars that devastated the local population.

By 1888, Germany had annexed Nauru, integrating it into its Pacific protectorate. The colonial rulers


introduced Christianity and plantation farming, but the island's destiny changed dramatically in 1900 with a discovery that would shape its future—vast phosphate deposits.

The Phosphate Boom: From Fortune to Ruin

Nauru sat on one of the world's richest phosphate reserves, a natural resource formed over millennia from bird droppings. Recognizing its immense value for agriculture, British and Australian interests took control of the deposits, transforming Nauru into a mining hub.

In 1914, Australia seized Nauru from Germany, and after World War I, the League of Nations officially placed the island under the joint administration of





Australia, the UK, and New Zealand. For decades, foreign companies extracted phosphate, fueling agricultural production worldwide—but leaving behind a devastated landscape.

During World War II, Japan occupied Nauru, forcibly deporting thousands of locals as laborers. After the war, Australia resumed its administration, but the islanders had begun demanding self-governance.

Independence and the Rise of a Microstate

On January 31, 1968, Nauru achieved full independence, becoming the smallest independent republic in the world. Unlike most countries, it has no official capital—government functions are based in Yaren District.

Nauru's tiny 18-member parliament is highly dynamic, with frequent leadership changes due to the island's small political landscape. The country enjoyed extraordinary wealth in the 1970s and 1980s, thanks to phosphate revenue, briefly making it one of the richest nations per capita.

Economic Collapse and a Struggle for Survival

The wealth, however, was short-lived. Decades of

reckless phosphate mining exhausted the reserves, leaving the island ecologically devastated and economically bankrupt. By the 1990s, Nauru was in crisis, forced to seek alternative revenue sources.

Over the years, the country has experimented with controversial financial schemes, including offshore banking, and later became a key player in Australia's offshore refugee processing program—hosting detention centers in exchange for economic aid.

A Nation at a Crossroads

Today, Nauru faces enormous challenges. With only 10,000 inhabitants, it struggles with:

- **Severe unemployment** after phosphate depletion.
- One of the highest obesity and diabetes rates in the world, due to a Western diet and lack of agriculture.
- A fragile political system, with frequent government turnovers.

STRENGTHENING SMEs Through Risk Management

MEs, accounting for 90% of businesses and over 50% of employment, face significant challenges due to limited risk management resources. In regions like Africa and Asia, robust risk management is crucial to tackle economic instability, cyber-attacks and environmental risks.

For SMEs, especially in emerging markets, cultivating a proactive risk culture is essential. In Africa and Asia, SMEs account for over 40% of GDP, yet they face heightened vulnerabilities due to limited access to risk mitigation tools. For example, in Nigeria, SMEs represent over 80% of employment but only 15% have insurance, exposing them to economic shocks. Risks like inflation, currency fluctuations and cybercrime disproportionately affect SMEs, demanding a risk-aware culture embedded across all levels of the organization.

Cybersecurity is a growing concern for SMEs globally as they are often under-prepared for cyber threats. A 2022 survey in Asia revealed that 44% of cyberattacks targeted SMEs. In regions like Africa and Southeast Asia, less than 20% of SMEs have adequate cybersecurity protections. For instance, a mid-sized e-commerce SME in Kenya that handles sensitive customer data is vulnerable without proper cybersecurity measures. Simple actions like staff training on phishing threats and securing communication channels can mitigate these risks.

Effective risk management begins with comprehensive risk assessments, particularly in high-risk sectors like agriculture and manufacturing. In India, for example, 60% of SMEs in agriculture and industry face challenges due to climate change and market fluctuations. SMEs must involve all employees in identifying and managing risks, fostering a culture of openness where risks are discussed and mitigated collectively.

SMEs in Southeast Asia and Africa are particularly vulnerable to environmental risks, such as natural disasters. In 2021, floods in Malaysia led to over \$600 million in losses for SMEs. To build resilience, SMEs should invest in insurance, strategic planning and adaptable business models to safeguard their operations against unpredictable events.

International organizations recognize the importance of strengthening SMEs' risk management capacity. The African Development Bank (AfDB) supports programs to help SMEs mitigate risks in unstable markets, while regional partnerships like the ASEAN SME Working Group assist SMEs in Asia with digital tools for risk management and crisis assessment.

To sum-up, global economies rely on SMEs, which carry more risks than larger firms. A proactive risk culture, involving all levels, helps SMEs weather economic, cyber and environmental crises. Governments and international agencies must provide accessible resources and risk management strategies.
